MASONRY DESIGN & CRAFTSMANSHIP EXCELLENCE AWARDS

INFORMATION AND CRITERIA

These awards are intended to honor masonry projects in the Mid-Atlantic region of the US recognizing the architect's for the design and the mason contractor for the execution of the masonry project.

A total of 6 Design and a total of 6 Craftsmanship projects can be chosen as award recipients from the following categories at the sole discretion of the judging panels. Projects submitted for both Design and Craftsmanship are eligible to win in both award programs.

PROJECT CATEGORIES

(Choose only one category per project when submitting. You may submit any project for both a Design and a Craftsmanship Award.)

- **Commercial** - to include retail, multi-residential, hospitality, office, etc...
- **Education** - to include K - 12 school, college and university buildings
- **Institutional/Government** - to include churches, any local municipal, state or national government building, fire departments, hospitals, libraries, military, etc...
- **Single Family Residential**
- **Architect's Choice** - presented to a project worthy of special recognition. This award may or may not be awarded and is at the sole discretion of the judging panel.

PROJECT ELIGIBILITY

Any project substantially completed within the past five years – 2015, 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019.

A project can be submitted by any MAMA Member. If the mason contractor for the project is non-MAMA member, then it can only win a Design Award.

AWARDS JUDGING AND PRESENTATION

DESIGN AWARDS

A panel of recognized architects, who do not have any nominations submitted, will judge the nominations and choose the winning entries.

CRAFTSMANSHIP AWARDS

A panel of masonry experts, who do not have any nominations submitted, will judge the nominations and choose the winning entries.

Winners will be chosen at the judge's discretion.

PRESENTATION

For each winning entry, the Architect and the Mid-Atlantic Masonry Association Mason Member will each receive an award plaque.

AWARDS SUBMITTAL CRITERIA

- All submittals must be made by the Mid-Atlantic Masonry Association Member and **must be received no later than September 20, 2019.**
- All photo submittals are accepted by digital format. No photo prints will be accepted.

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- Narratives are to be submitted in Microsoft Word format. No handwritten or faxed narratives will be accepted. Narratives should include relevant information about the project and the masonry materials used.
- Narratives and photos are to be labeled to insure that the right photos and narratives are matched. The quality of the photography is a key element for the judging. Therefore, we recommend that you send as many high resolution photos on a CD (or ftp for download) labeled as to the project and narrative to accompany the photo.

All photos submitted will become the property of the Mid-Atlantic Masonry Association and may be used in promotional efforts on our website or in printed materials with no reference to the producing member, architect, installer or owner of the building or structure.

HELPFUL HINTS WHEN SUBMITTING ENTRIES:

- Presentation is important. Compose your photos (lighting, background, etc.)
- Completed projects show the best with landscaping, etc... in place
- As many photos of the project as possible and a narrative help give the judges the most information to properly choose the winning projects.
- Use a camera that can provide you with high resolution digital photos
- Show the judges what you want them to see with special close-ups on details that highlight the project to help to set your project apart from the competition. Note that the installation and joints will be noticed by the judges.
- Professional photography is helpful but not a necessity.

SUBMITTAL FEE

A submittal fee of \$100 per entry is required. Any Mid-Atlantic Masonry Association Member may submit projects.
