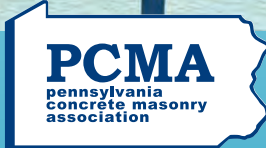

"Building with Confidence: Structural Masonry Special Inspections and Anchoring to Masonry"

Mike Padula, PE, CWI - Regional Vice President, Pennoni

This one-hour seminar provides an overview of the special inspection requirements for structural masonry construction as outlined in **Chapter 17 of IBC 2021** and **TMS 402/602**. The session focuses on how these requirements are applied in practice during masonry construction.

The seminar also reviews common quality control and testing procedures used to verify that masonry materials comply with project design specifications. In addition, it covers commonly specified masonry connection types and explains how these connections are inspected to confirm compliance with manufacturer installation requirements and the intent of the structural engineer's design.

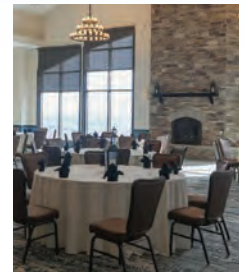

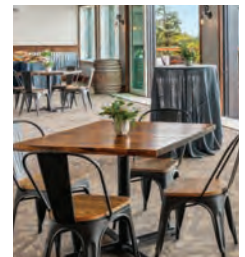

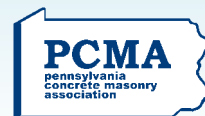
